For this four- to five-page essay, please choose as your primary text (the text on which the central component of your argument will hinge) one of the six essays we've read in this sequence. The authors you may choose from are Jefferson, Douglass, Anthony, Friedan, Allen, and Milk.

Please write either a **rebuttal argument** essay or a **causal argument** essay – carefully following the guidelines posted online, on the “Causal Argument” and “Rebuttal Argument” handouts.

Upon considering one of the above texts as your “primary text,” you will then in your essay:

- demonstrate/disprove causality for the claim or central issue, in a causal argument
- agree or disagree with the author's argument, in a rebuttal

In addition to the text you have chosen to use as your primary text, you will need to use **two additional research sources**. Following the criteria we discussed in class, you will need to locate peer-reviewed research sources to support your argument or to deepen the context for the issue you are investigating. You will need to introduce each source in full and quote from each at least twice. Don't forget your works cited page!

Remember to follow the grammar and structure guidelines established for Essay One.
